There may be only one supervising teacher for each student. Other teachers are considered Other Assisting Teachers.
Supplemental Instruction	<ul> <li>Must be in addition to the student's regular course load. Examples are:</li> <li>for an alternative school using independent study—summer school.</li> <li>for an independent study program of a comprehensive school—during the summer, before or after the school day, or during a holiday or vacation period.</li> </ul>
Synchronous Online	Students and the teacher are online at the same time for class sessions.
Variable Credit	In alternative and adult schools, students may earn partial credit within a period of time or semester.
Work Product	Results from a student's efforts and actions to complete or perform the assignment given and which is evaluated by a certificated teacher for ADA.
